Who are we?

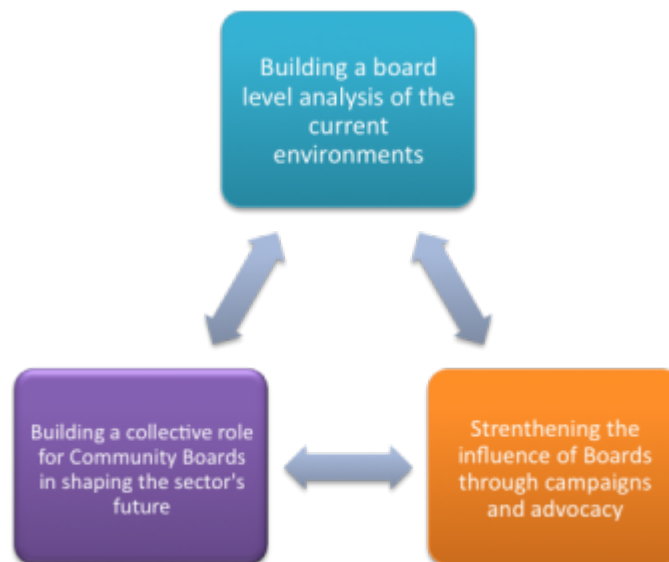
With current changes (and those still to come) with the Community Services sector, small and medium not for profit organisations are feeling the impact. Conversations between Board members about pressures on their agencies and staff, changed funding mechanisms, increased wages and decreased capacity for community and preventive work has led to the establishment of a Coalition of Community Boards.

Coalition of Community Boards Whitsunday, Isaac & Mackay (COCBWIM) is a regional collaborative group of board members within the Whitsunday, Isaac and Mackay region. The group is a sub-committee of the Regional Social Development Centre (RSDC) which reports to the Regional Policy General Committee of RSDC and liaise with the Queensland Coalition of Community Boards.

What do we do?

As a regional collaborative board the Coalition of Community Boards Whitsunday, Isaac & Mackay aims to work collaboratively with board members within the region to develop innovative and sustainable strategies aimed at strengthening our region's community sector.
